JANUARY 2024

Sean Donoghue

The indoor season proper kicked in during January therefore our resources were spread across road, cross country and indoor. Our men's team recorded a solid win in the Leinster Intermediate cross country championships, our first title in several decades.

January 1st We fielded both a women's and men's team in the traditional first event of the year, the Tommy Brennan Memorial 5k road race. Our women's team had won this on the previous five occasions and made no mistake this time, winning again with an exceptionally low score of 15 points. Great running by the men also finishing in 11th position.

The windless conditions were ideal for road racing and there was excellent running by all our athletes most of whom recorded personal bests. Unfortunately the course was later reputed to be approximately 100m under distance but even with an adjustment of some 20/25 secs many personal bests were had. A great start to the year.

January 7th Paul McLoughlin performed well on his debut at the Dublin Masters Cross Country Championships in Raheny.

January 13th Paulo Silva competing in the Irish Masters Indoor Championships won the Long Jump and was second in the 60m in his age category. In Seattle USA Ronan McMahon Skaggs opened his indoor season with a win over 1000m.

January 14th Philip Marron ran an excellent 3.47.71 in an invitational race in Athlone. In Drogheda Oran O'Hare was 2nd in the R-ACE over 5k.

January 20th Edel Monaghan and Orla Duffy competed in the London Cross country Challenge in Parliament Fields.

January 21st Our men's and women's Intermediate Cross Country teams ran in windswept and heavy rain at Avondale, Rathdrum, finishing 1st and 2nd teams respectively. This was our first men's cross country win at senior level for almost 40 years.

January 26th Sean Donohoe ran under 4 minutes for the mile at the University of Pennsylvania Indoor International meeting. Clíodhna Ryan ran a fine 6th place in the North Leinster school's championships.

January 27th Philip Marron and Conor Duncan competed in the 1500m and Edel Monaghan in the 3000m at the AAI Indoor Games at Abbotstown. Ronan McMahon Staggs continued his early season form with a fast mile in Seattle. Fiona Hawkins had two fine runs at altitude over a mile and 3000m.

FEBRUARY 2024

February brought the cross country season to a close and we ended up retaining the national intermediate title, third year in succession, and travelling to Portugal to compete in the European cross country championships.

The indoor season also drew to a close and our members competed excellently at the senior championships in Abbottstown. Meanwhile in Australia Jodie continued to blasé a trail on the track.

February 4th Brilliant run by Cristin Scollard in the Dungarvan 10 mile road race.

February 7th Philip Marron and Conor Duncan have excellent runs over 800m at the NIA.

February 9th Sean Donohoe recorded his second sub four minute indoor mile in Chicago, USA.

February 8th Three athletes, Niamh Carr, Edel Monaghan and Aoife Carr competed in the annual Armagh road race over 3000m

February 10th Faye Dervan, Joe Fogarty, Edel Monaghan, Claire O'Connor and Sorcha McAllister represented their respective colleges at the University Indoor Championships in Abbottstown.

Overnight, news came in from Australia that Jodie McCann broke the club 1500m record with a magnificent 4.08.34 posting.

February 11th The last national cross country championships of the 2023/24 season brought us to Dundalk where we fielded two strong teams both men and women. While the women were defending the title they won for the last two years this was our first time in many years to field a men's team. On an extremely mucky course our women retained their title and in fact we entered two teams. The men finished 3rd in a very competitive race to consolidate an extremely busy season.

February 14th Another huge run by Jodie in Australia recording 15.35.05 for 5000m

February 16th Ronan recorded a fast 800m in Arkansas.

February 17th The first day of the national indoor championships was held in Abbottstown where we had seven athletes competing in the qualifying heats.

February 18th On the second day of the indoor championships there were excellent performances from Edel Monaghan, Pierre Murchan and Philip Marron. We had a small team competing in Ras na hEireann in Dunleer where we had the winning women's team. Conor Murphy ran a fine solo effort in the men's race.

February 24th Aoife Carr, running her third race in 16 days, helped her Scottish club, Shettleston Harriers to third place in their national championships.

Niamh Carr qualified for the final of the 1500m at the BUCS indoor championships in Sheffield.

In the USA Sean Donohoe finished fourth in the Big East mile championship and helped his college Villanova to the 4 X mile relay championship. Ronan Staggs ran 800m in the DMR for his Washington State University where they finished 9th in their regional championships

February 25th Really busy weekend for club members. Niamh Carr competed in the BUCS 1500m indoor championships.

A large group of members descended upon Albufeira to compete in the European Cross Country Championships. We had qualified for both the women's long course race and the mixed relay. Aoife Carr joined up with us there to run with Shettleston Harriers. We were also represented in the open races there. Some really good results recorded and a lot to take away. Looking back, our women's team won this championship in Albufeira in 1986, retaining the title they won in Madrid in 1985. The team on that occasion was, Anne Hilliard-8th, Greta Hickey-11th, Deirdre Nagle-13th, Ailish Smyth-18th, Ursula Noctor (RIP)-28th and Eithne Kenny-33rd.

February 28th We had a number of athletes competing in the NIA Live Indoor Meeting

MARCH 2024

March was a relatively quiet month on the domestic scene bringing as it does the end of both the cross country seasons. We began our quest to win the Peugeot sponsored road race series on St Patrick's Day in Portlaoise. Jodie continued her excellent form in Australia in her aim of achieving qualification for the European Championships in Rome, and the Olympic Games in Paris.

March 9th The Irish Universities Cross Country Championships and the Irish Schools Cross Country Championships were held in Belfast and Dublin respectively. Our club was well represented at both venues.

March 17th We travelled to Portlaoise to participate in the first leg of the nine race Peugeot series. We recorded some excellent results and carry forward 2nd place in the team grand prix to the next race.

March 24th Jodie McCann recorded another big improvement and set a club record over 3000m at the Australian Championships. Our women's team finished 2nd and the men 7th at the National 10k road championships in Dunboyne. This is the first time we ever had women's and men's teams competing at these championships.

March 27th Jodie McCann produced another big performance and set a club record over 1 mile at the Australian Championships.

March 28th The Peugeot GP moved to Kilkenny tonight for which we struggled to field a team. Pierre recorded a fantastic time winning the individual race in a course record. It appears that we now lie in third place in the GP with 16 points after the first two races.

June 29th A packed weekend faced us with the 6th leg of the Peugeot race series over 10 miles being held in Roscommon. We travelled there with a weakened team, assembled late in the day but showing great gusto we finished 2nd overall and maintained our grip on second place in the grand prix.

Day one of the national senior track and field championships were held on a rain soaked Morton Stadium. Finishing 6th in her heat Edel Monaghan was unlucky not to qualify for the 1500m final as fastest loser. A recent technical rule change shunted her out. Niamh Carr in her first race following injury performed solidly to qualify for the final, but Fiona Hawkins found herself in a very slow heat and didn't get through. Both Sean Donohoe and Philip Marron navigated their paths to the final in tactical heats. Oran O'Hare had a great run in his 5000m heat finishing 4th in a personal best.

June 30th Day two of the national championships was held in reasonable weather and some good performances. Jodie won the 5000m and in so doing won her place in the Paris Olympics. Cliona, Edel Monaghan and Sorcha also ran in the 5000m. Ailish Hawkins came a creditable 6th in the steeplechase in 10.48.16. Niamh Carr clearly unfit ran valiantly in the 1500m final. Sean Donohoe and Philip Marron finished creditable 8th and 9th respectively in a tactical men's 1500m.

The July highlight was Jodie's selection for the Olympic Games in Paris in the 5000m. Our road team completed the Peugeot series in a 10 mile race in Edenderry, finishing 2nd team overall. Following a few year s plagued by injury, Nadia made a welcome return to the track recording some encouraging performances. Sean Donohue set a new under 23 5m record in the Morton Mile at Santry. JP Williamson and Eoghan Berry both finished under 53 mins in the National miles championships.

July 3rd Fiona Hawkins won the grade A 1500m at the Dublin Graded League and Grace Culhane finished 7th in grade C.

July 6th Nadia Power showed a return to winning ways taking the 800m at the Birmingham BMC meeting. Kieron Sexton also won his heat over 1500m at the same meeting. Edel Monaghan ran a fine personal best over 1500m at the British League meeting in Woodford Green.

July 7th Jodie McCann was selected to represent Ireland in the 5000m at the Paris Olympic Games.

July 9th Sean Donohoe recorded a huge personal best of 3.56.90 for the mile in Cork.

July 11th A group of athletes competed in the Dockland 5k with Sorcha McAllister recording 16.59 in 2nd place.

July 12th Sean Donohoe followed up his fine run in Cork recording another PB 3.55.71, a new Irish under 23 record, in the Morton Mile.

October 6th Our women's team finished a creditable 6th in the Dublin Novice Cross Country Championships. Christopher and Paul McLoughlin both competed in the men's race.

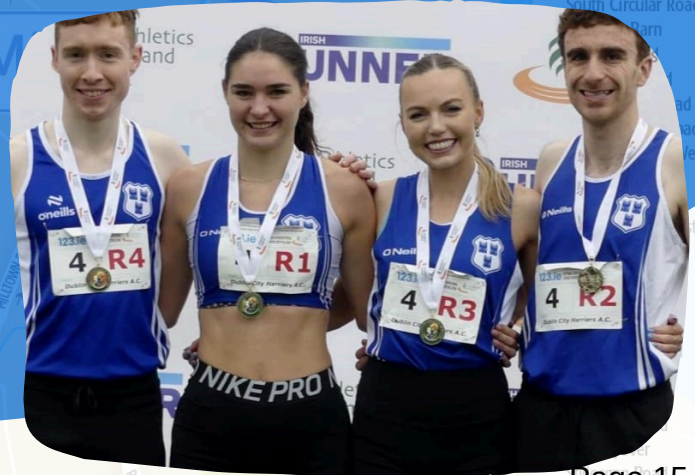

Lauren Tinkler, Edel Monaghan, Orla Duffy and Cliona Murphy has excellent runs in the womens open race. Both Conor Murphy and Christopher McLoughlin competed admirably in the men's open race.

October 19th Pierre Murchan won the Intervarsities Cross Country Championships in what would be his last appearance for Trinity College. Michael Ryan finished 79th while Christopher McLoughlin was 84th. In the women's section Faye Dervan was 21st and Sarah Byrne 78th. In Scotland Aoife Carr recorded the second fastest time in the National Relay Championships there. Ronan Staggs recorded a fast 23.44 for 8k cross country in Wisconsin and Sean Donohoe recorded 23.38 over the same distance at Princeton.

October 20th We had a large group competing in the Leinster Novice Cross Country Championships where our women's team finished 2nd.

October 27th Five members, most debutees, competed in the Dublin City Marathon where we finished a men's team for the first time. Unfortunately we had only two women competing and therefore didn't close in a scoring team.

Our main competitive aim, the National Senior cross country championships, for the year fell in November. Unfortunately our women's team fell short of the target, but our mens team won the B section. We were the only Dublin club to win team medals on the day. Individual places on the Irish team for the European Champions are selected from this race and Pierre Murchan gained his place following an excellent individual run. Preceding that was the Dublin Championships where we won the women's title with ease.

November 2nd A group of some nine members competed in the Abbottstown Park Run where a number of personal bests were recorded. Aoife Carr finished an excellent 9th in the Scottish Short Course Cross Country Championships.



November 3rd The Dublin Cross Country Championships were held on a new course at City West. Formally a golf facility the course was undulating, with both good running and muddy patches. Cliona Ryan finished an excellent 7th in the junior section while the senior womens team of Orla Duffy, Edel Monaghan, SORCHA McAllister, Cliona Murphy, Bonnie McFeat and Aoife Corr combined to retain the Jim McNamara trophy, winning for the fourth year in succession.

November 8th We had three athletes representing their colleges at the Irish Universities Road Relay championships in Maynooth. Pierre Murchan posted the fastest 3 lap leg of the day.

November 16th Ailish Hawkins ran a fine 21.14 over 6k finishing 3rd scorer for UCLA in the NCAA West Regional Conference Cross Country Championships. Ronan Staggs was timed at 29.53 over 10k finishing 6th scorer for Washington State at the same meeting.

November 17th We had some sixteen athletes competing at the National Senior/Junior Cross Country Championships on Enniskillen. Our women's team fought hard in defence of the title but had to give way in the end. Our men's team, competing at these championships for many years finished a creditable 7th overall, and captured the "B" team title.

November 20th Pierre Murchan voted Universities Athlete of the year at the AAI annual awards day.

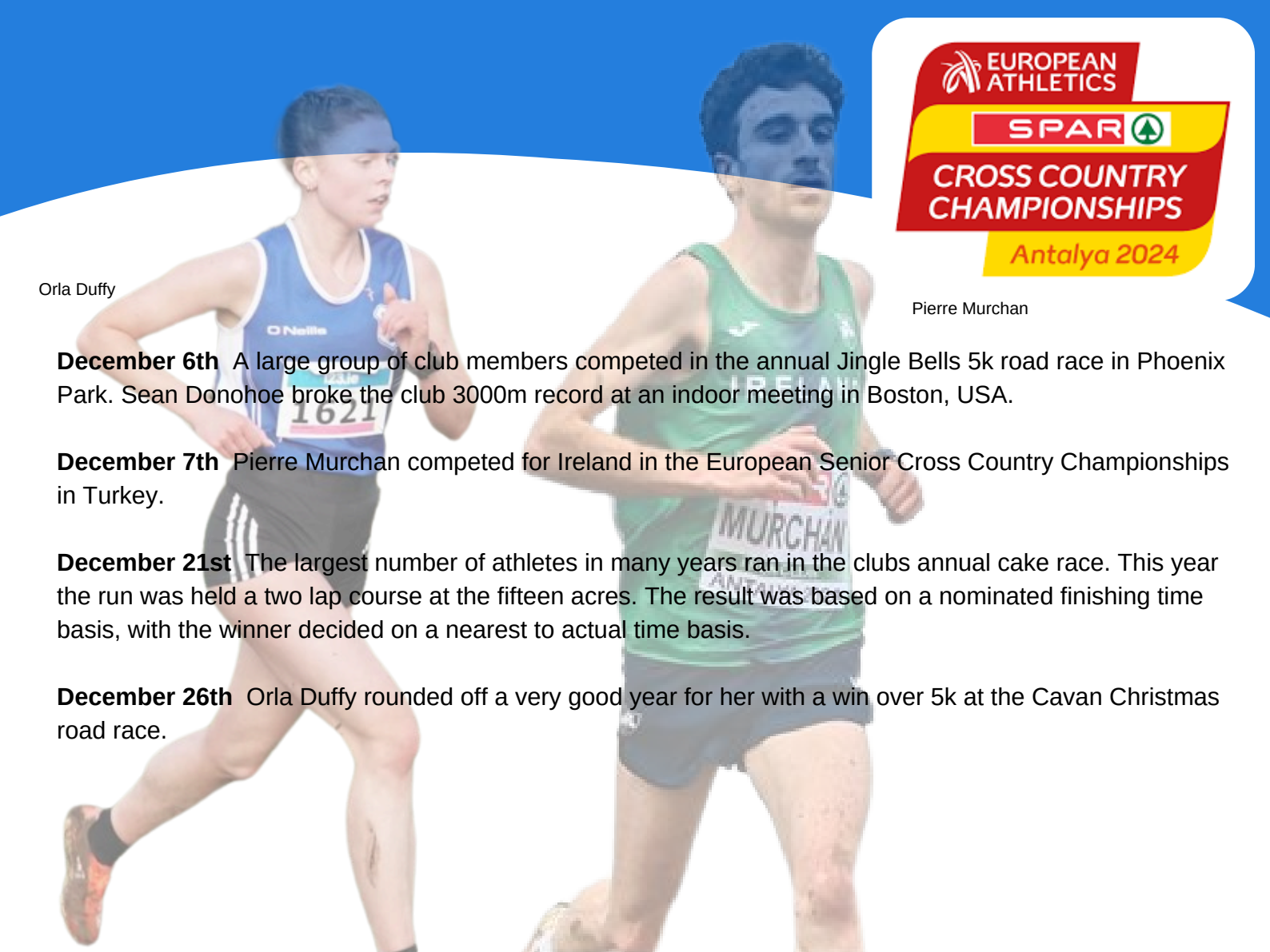


December 5th We learned today with immense sadness of the death of former captain Dave Fagan. Dave was a thrower, specialising in shot and discus who joined us as a junior in the 1980s. His first recorded performances for DCH were in the National Junior championships in 1982. Following that he established himself as an excellent shot putter who contributed hugely to club teams who won numerous national league titles, and represented DCH in the European clubs championships in Paris and London. Dave was a brilliant club man and could always be relied upon to bag huge points in interclub competition. Following his competitive career he turned to coaching with great success and brought through several young throwers for DCH and other clubs. He was appointed as throws coach by the then BLE and was part of the athletics coaching team at the Olympic Games in Barcelona in 1992 and Beijing in 2008. In 1995 Dave was recruited by Leinster Rugby as strength and conditioning coach. He continued in that role, particularly with the academy players, and was highly regarded in rugby circles. It appears that Dave had a fall at training in September following which he received a grim diagnosis at the hospital he attended. At 60 years of age Dave was taken too soon, his contribution to DCH was considerable. He will always be remembered with kindness by those who knew him.

There are unwritten laws of Athletics, the breach of which not only causes anger and discomfort to one's opponents, but is no less excusable than infringements of the code as set down in the rule books.

Most breaches of etiquette are committed in error or by lack of thought. The great athlete is usually a well behaved one. And a well behaved considerate competitor is the one who becomes popular with his fellow sports-men and who, in consequence, gets more pleasure from his active and social sporting life.

POINT TO REMEMBER.

YOUR CLUB. Pay your club subscription promptly. Every athletic club needs the financial backing which subscriptions from members provide. The club's honorary treasurer is a voluntary worker, carrying out his duties on your behalf. Do not add to his difficulties or labour by making it necessary for him to remind you of your obligations. Answer letters promptly, particularly if they are from your club captain or secretary. Reminders take time and cost money, and it is discourteous and unhelpful to those who are working in the best interests of yourself and your fellow club members, to be left in doubt of your intentions, or of your ability to turn out on a specific occasion. Above all be loyal. Be guided in every action by your sense of duty to your club. Only in exceptional circumstances should you consider transferring your membership.

THE DRESSING ROOM. Behaviour in the dressing room is a most important part of an athlete's conduct. Be early, do not take up more than your fair share of space, and do not leave your clothes spread all round. Do not leave valuables in your clothing. This constitutes a temptation to the weakminded, and provides opportunities for the deliberately dishonest; loss throws suspicion on many who are innocent (completely) and leads to strained relationships and general resentment.

Be careful that your athletic clothing is clean. Dirty attire can be an offense to others in the dressing room. Avoid evil smelling linements etc., which have no real medical value and offend the nostrils of other competitors. Do not clean your spikes in the dressing room leaving the mud or track dirt for others to walk on. Be clean in your personal habits and avoid dirty toenails and feet. They can give offense to others who have a high standard of personal cleanliness. Avoid bad language; athletics is a sport beloved by all, and there is a surprisingly large number of persons who, without necessarily being prudish, have a deep objection to swearing or vulgar talk.

ON THE TRACK. Do not complain or grumble, and do not make excuses for defeat. If there is justification for excusing yourself your fellow competitors will be quick to make it for you. A cheerful loser, who regards misfortune as all in the game is well on the way to becoming a good and deserving winner. Do not boast in the flush of victory. Modesty when one is feeling on "top of the world" is essential in a true sportsman. Be punctual at the start of a race it is discourteous to keep fellow competitors and officials waiting. DURING THE RACE. To try to beat the starter is cheating, a victory gained by this means can give no real satisfaction. In a race round the track remember that courtesy to your opponents is expected of you. Bumping and pushing may be "all in the game" but such a game is not athletics. Every competitor is entitled to a fair race and carelessness or deliberately unfair tactics may result in serious injury or at best prevent the best man securing the reward of his efforts, even though the culprit be disqualified. Some athletes enter for several events, and having qualified for the latter stages of two or more, decide to forego one to concentrate on an other. This really is an unfair practice, for in qualifying for more finals than you intend to compete in, you have prevented another competitor from being in the final of the race you wish to forego. Be fair therefore, and avoid competing unless you intend to pursue the race to its final conclusion.
